	Comfortable Walking Shoes
	Other Shoes As Needed (don't forget Formal Night Shoes!)

<b>Check</b>	<b>Item Description</b>
	Pants/Shorts for daily casual wear (to pack lighter, remember they can be re-worn!)
	Tops/Shirts for daily casual wear (again, these can be used more than once!)
	Belts
	Formal Wear as needed for Formal Dinners
	Swimsuits (bring an extra large t-shirt for wearing over swimsuit around ship)
	Water Shoes/Sandals (for wearing to/from pool and on water related excursions)
	Hats (you may want one to avoid sunburn while at tropical ports)
	Undergarments
	Workout Clothing

	Razor
	Toothbrush
	Soap
	Hairbrushes/Combs
	Fingernail/Toenail Clips
	Makeup
	Feminine Items

	Curling Iron
	Straightener
	Sunscreen
	Solarcaine or equivalent (in case that sunscreen doesn't work!)

	Fanny Pack (great for hauling personal items around – especially in port)
	Neck Lanyard (attach your <i>Sea Pass</i> card to this for use on ship – no wallet needed)
	Beach Bag (also good for carrying souvenirs back to ship)
